Golf Course Update

Golf Course Update

Members,

As many of you have already heard we will be going to 18 temporary greens for the month of May. This is not a decision that was easy to make. However, we feel that it is the best solution to get our golf course ready for the summer months. We have attacked the nematode problem but without the help of warmer nights it has been tough to get the turf to start growing. We have a plan for getting the greens back into the shape our ownership, staff and membership expect.

One of the main reasons for going to temporary greens is to allow us to have the ability to set regular irrigation cycles to keep the seed moist and avoid foot traffic during the germination process. Beginning the 1st week of May we will be going through the following process to get more coverage of turf on all the greens.

- · Verticut bad areas to allow seed to penetrate soil
- · Apply seed to the areas where it is needed and overlapping the already grown in areas.
- · Apply organic fertilizer on top of the seed
- · Topdress greens with sand.
- · Cut and Sod Holes #2 and #8 with new bentgrass

The golf course and driving range will remain open. To make your rounds more enjoyable we suggest that groups play automatic 2 putts inside the green area. We will not be posting any scores into the handicaps while we are using the temporary greens.

We appreciate your understanding and support of Hillcrest Country Club while we work to get the golf course back into great shape.
