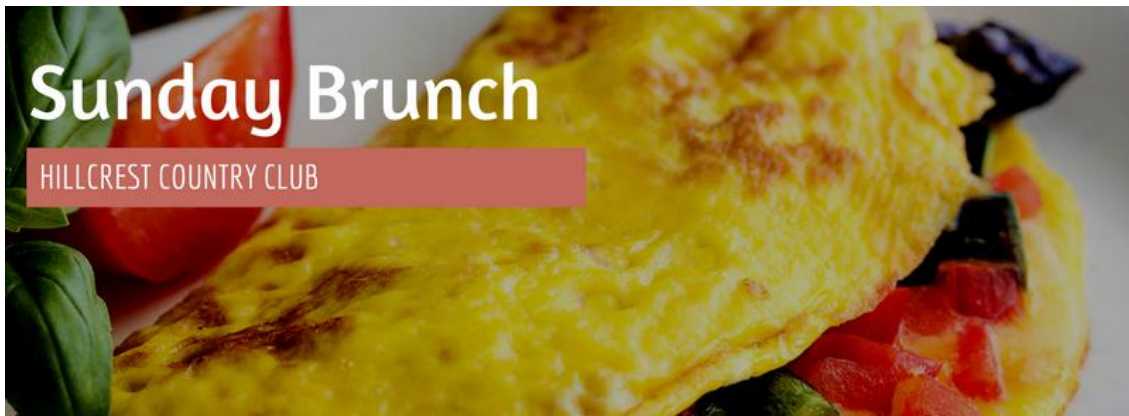

Tennis News:

Greetings Tennis Players,

Most of our members play doubles and this month's topic is on poaching in doubles. There are two types of poaches, one is planned and one is unplanned. It is always good as the server's partner to be ready to pounce on a weak return of serve for a poach. However, there are a few reasons to abort a poach. Here are some reasons to stop your poach in midflight and quickly side step back into your original position.

- If, having started a poach, you see that the ball is hit hard and headed for your partners's alley, you would probably never catch up with it. You should retreat.
- If you have crossed into your partner's court and find that when the ball reaches you it is around net level or below, step away and let the ball go through to your partner.
- If your opponents play your partner's serve very early and from very close to the service line, it may also be taken on the rise. In this case, you should retreat as you have little time to react to the ball.

In some cases, which require approval by management, the former member may reinstate their membership by paying the account in-full, plus monthly dues that have passed in the interim. Otherwise, the member cannot make application to the club for a period of one calendar year from the time that their membership is terminated and only then if the account has been paid in-full.
