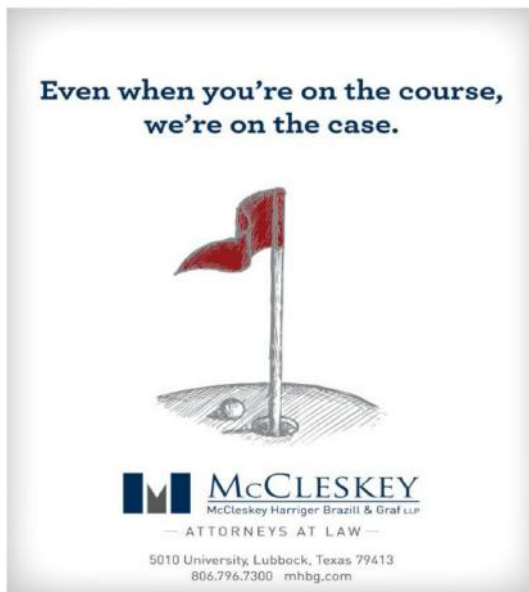

Headley's Hints

Each month I will provide some helpful tips on how to approach each hole for maximum scoring. Happy Golf!

HOLE #1

Par: 4

Yards: 389

The proper tee shot is essential to #1 as a poor drive can lead to a difficult place to recover from. The prevailing wind is normally right into the golfer off this tee. Hit the best club in your bag to keep the ball in between the bunker and the large Elm Tree on the left side of the fairway.

On your approach be mindful of going long. Long is not where you want to be. Playing from short of this hole on your 3rd shot tends to be a much easier chance for a birdie or par. Even if you are on the green the downhill putt can get away from you.

Tennis News:

Hello Tennis Players,

Thanks to all who supported our summer tennis camps. The kids seemed to have a good time and improved their skills. Best of luck to these players in the 2018-19 school season.

This month's newsletter concerns preparing for a big match by Bill Norris. Bill has been the main athletic trainer for the professional tennis tour for over forty years. He has an interesting book out called Pain, Set and Match. Concerning pre match preparation, he suggests starting the day with a hot bath or shower to get the body core temperature elevated. Then he suggests scooting up against a wall and putting your legs up, propping them up the wall. The elevation will help drain the blood back into the core and that helps with circulation. Stay in the position for five minutes. Then it is best to stretch the hamstrings, quads, calf muscles, back, arms, etc. He also recommends some analgesic balm into your shoulders, forearms, legs and lower back. This will help warm up the muscles and help with any aches and pains you might have. Norris also suggests that the one should apply a thin coating of Vaseline and a bit of baby powder on the balls of the feet, heels and toes to help prevent blisters. Following a match, it is best to take a cold shower or ice bath to help reduce inflammation.

Members of the club are expected to pay their accounts in-full on a monthly basis. If a member's account is over 30 days past due, the member is assessed a \$20 late payment fee. In some cases, which require approval by management, the former member may reinstate their membership by paying the account in-full, plus monthly dues that have passed in the interim. Otherwise, the member cannot make application to the club for a period of one calendar year from the time that their membership is terminated and only then if the account has been paid in-full.
